



Announcement of Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University
Subject: Application for the Ph.D. Student Exchange Scholarship for Fiscal Year 2026

In order to promote internationalization alongside the development of graduate students through the enhancement of international academic networks, and to provide opportunities for international students to conduct research and exchange knowledge at Prince of Songkla University (Inbound).

The Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University, hereby announces the call for applications for the Ph.D. Student Exchange Scholarship for Fiscal Year 2026, with details as follows:

1. Number of Scholarships: 20 scholarships

2. Scholarship Value: 180,000 THB

The scholarship amount is divided as follows:

- For scholarship recipient: 100,000 THB
- For an international supervisor, in cases where the advisor travels to follow up on the student's research progress during the research period at Prince of Songkla University: 80,000 THB

3. Eligibility Criteria: Applicants must:

- 3.1 Be international students currently enrolled in a Ph.D. program and maintain their student status throughout the research period, which must be a minimum of 8 months.
- 3.2 Have a high level of competence in English communication.
- 3.3 Have successfully passed the dissertation proposal examination.

4. Required Application Documents

- 4.1 Application form via Google form
- 4.2 Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 4.3 Copy of Passport (valid for at least 6 months)
- 4.4 A certified copy of transcript of records for master's degree study with grades and grade point average in English
- 4.5 Letter of Recommendation from an advisor at applicant's home institution
- 4.6 Letter of Acceptance from the host advisor
- 4.7 Evidence of having passed the dissertation proposal examination
- 4.8 English proficiency test results (If available, this will be considered as a special qualification.)

5. Scholarship Conditions

- 5.1 The recipient must have published at least one research article in an international academic journal indexed in Scopus or Web of Science, under co-publication or co-authorship.

5.2 The Published/...

- 5.2 The published article must include the following acknowledgment: *“This research was supported by the Ph.D. Student Exchange Scholarship of Prince of Songkla University.”*
- 5.3 The recipient must participate in research activities for a period of not less than 6 months.
- 5.4 The recipient may be responsible for additional expenses not covered by the scholarship.
- 5.5 Upon completion of the research period, the recipient must submit a progress report on the collaborative research conducted with Prince of Songkla University.
- 5.6 In the event that the recipient fails to comply with the above conditions, the full amount of the scholarship must be refunded, unless there are force majeure circumstances such as sudden illness, natural disasters, accidents, political unrest, or disease outbreaks. In such cases, a written explanation with supporting reasons must be submitted to the Graduate School for consideration on a case-by-case basis.

6. Selection Criteria

- 6.1 Preliminary screening will be conducted based on the following considerations:
- Fulfillment of eligibility criteria and submission of complete supporting documents as specified in the announcement
 - Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA)
 - English proficiency test scores.
- 6.2 The Graduate School will rank eligible applicants based on cumulative GPA and English proficiency scores for further consideration.
- 6.3 The decision on scholarship allocation made by the Dean of the Graduate School shall be final and not subject to appeal.
